

I am writing to inform you of upcoming works on Station Road, Castle Cary. As you are likely aware, Somerset Highways have had temporary traffic signals in place for some time, and we are hoping to have a permanent resolution in place soon.

Investigatory and preparation works will start on Monday 9 February under a road closure. This will be in place between 08.00 – 17.00 weekdays only with the road reopened outside of these times. Unfortunately, due to the excavations and equipment in place we are not able to allow bus access during these times.

Prior to the closure being in place there will be advanced signage on site to inform the travelling public. While the road is closed a signed diversion will be in place. These works will not conflict with the closure of the B3153 as Station Road will be reopened before these take place.

It is important to note that once we have completed this phase, the temporary signals will need to be put back in place. We hope that this will only be a temporary measure and that main works will start in March. However, we cannot say for certain at this time as we need to review the results of the above works and arrange for drainage consents.
